NYC'S PERIDANCE CONTEMPORARY DANCE COMPANY TO PERFORM TWO SHOWS AT COCA

Leader in Expressive & Innovative Dance Brings Captivating Artistry to St. Louis Community

ST. LOUIS (September 24, 2024)—Audiences will experience the captivating artistry of Peridance
Contemporary Dance Company (PCDC), New York City's premiere repertory company under the direction of renowned choreographer Igal Perry, as they bring two evenings of performance to COCA – Center of Creative Arts on Friday, October 4, and Saturday, October 5, at 7:30 p.m.

The program will feature favorite repertoire such as Yue Yin's "Just Above the Surface" (2020) and Perry's "Bolero" (1983) and "Valses Poeticos" (1987), as well as a new work from PCDC's latest season, "the space between" (2024) by Chanel DaSilva.

Described by the New York Times as "blessedly inventive," PCDC has been a leader in expressive and innovative dance since 1983. The company has an illustrious performance history at venues including the Joyce Theater, Lincoln Center, and internationally in Italy, Argentina, South Korea, and beyond, introducing the sheer emotionality of contemporary dance to new audiences.

"In honor of our commitment to bridge the gap between pre-professional and professional dance, COCA is thrilled to present our 2024 collaboration with New York City-based Peridance Contemporary Dance Company," said Kirven Douthit-Boyd, COCA's Associate Director of Dance. "This effort provides an exciting opportunity for COCA's pre-professional artists and the St. Louis community to engage in the creative process and product."

PCDC's performances conclude a 2-week residency with company artists that brings COCA's pre-professional artists in direct contact with Perry's choreography. As part of the engagement, PCDC will lead two masterclasses, one for COCA students and one open to the public. The PCDC Community Masterclass for intermediate to advanced dancers will be held on Thursday, October 3, from 5:00–7:00 p.m. Tickets are \$15. The St. Louis community is also invited to attend a free film screening of Call Me Dancer, a film by Leslie Shampaine that stars PCDC dancer Manish Chauhan, on Thursday, October 3, from 7:00–9:00 p.m.

Tickets to Peridance Contemporary Dance Company's performances are \$31 and may be purchased at cocastl.org or by contacting the COCA Box Office at 314.561.4873. \$5 Student Rush tickets will be available at the COCA Box Office one hour before showtime on a first-come, first-served basis. The performance is recommended for ages 10 and older.
